

Children and Puppies Obstacle Course

Let's encourage children and puppies to bond and have fun in a safe way!

1. Print attached signs.
2. Laminate them or slide them into a clear sleeve.
3. Tape little popsicle sticks on each end and push sticks into sod.
4. Place "Start" sign in ground then arrange the rest of the signs in any order you like. Place obstacles to weave around (like cones from dollar store), climb over (like a solid box), and go through (like a hula-hoop – you can use two pieces of styrofoam, cut a line in each and secure hula hoops in them).
5. You can also put various footings down like stones, wood, indoor/outdoor carpeting, towels, tiles, etc... to make the course even more interesting and engaging.
6. You can turn a clear plastic cup upside down with a treat inside for puppy to find while on the course.
7. The options are endless with a little creativity!
8. Children can then lure puppies around with treats to get them to do the obstacle course or better yet, children can take the lead with puppy following eagerly. Just make sure obstacles aren't high for puppies.

I would record the sessions, if possible. Great childhood memories and wonderful bonding opportunities!

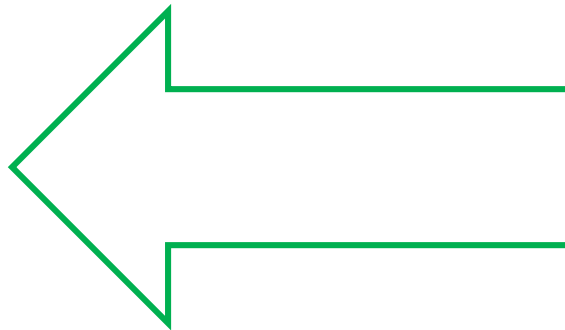

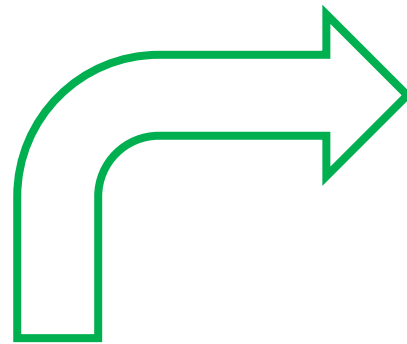
